## HIGH SCHOOL LEARNING SPECIALIST 9-12

### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:**

The High School Learning Specialist (HSL) ensures that students, parents and staff are provided the support necessary to be successful in grades 9-12. HSLs serve as a resource to teachers (classroom management and instructional practices), parents (information and communication), and students (supervision and activities) while assisting students/staff in attaining a meaningful, enriched school experience.

### **MAJOR DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Works with high school teachers, developing strategies to enhance student success.
2. Reinforces/implements the school management plan.
3. Participates in parent/teacher conferences, SSTs, 504s and IEPs as appropriate.
4. Provides leadership in curriculum and special projects.
5. Conducts demonstration lessons to introduce instructional practices.
6. Assists teachers in interpreting, assessing and planning for student assessment.

### **OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Takes an active role in promoting the school's objectives to students, parents, and the community at large while fostering a positive relationship.
2. Participates in assigned/appropriate playground, lunch, bus or other supervision activities.
3. Collaborate with middle school personnel to ensure a smooth transition to the high school level.

### **SUPERVISION:**

Works under the direct supervision of the principal.

### **SALARY:**

Appropriate placement on the certificated salary schedule and a ratio of 1.15.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Possession of a valid California Teaching Credential authorizing secondary service.
- Preferably 5 or more years of teaching experience.
- Demonstrate a commitment to ongoing professional growth by attending coursework, workshops or seminars that pertain to student performance, leadership, curriculum development, instructional practices or assessing student data.

### **OTHER:**

Must have a minimum of five years of secondary teaching experience  
Master's degree is desirable.
